

Citizensense user guide

Citizensense is a generic user-oriented participatory sensing framework, aiming to ease the process of creating and managing participatory sensing campaigns. From the user's view, the Citizensense framework consists of two components: The web application and the mobile application (app). A single account is needed to use both these two components. The account can be registered once in the web application or in the Citizensense app.

2. The Citizensense mobile app

2.1. Registration and log in

On the first use of the app, users are required to either register or log in. To register, click on the "Register" button and fill in the form. To log in, please type the registered email and password.

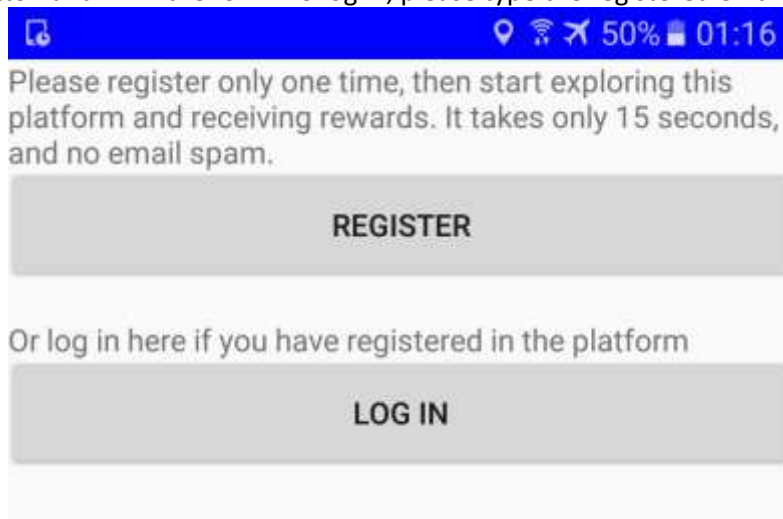


Figure 8: First screen when using the Citizensense app

2.2. Execute sensing campaigns

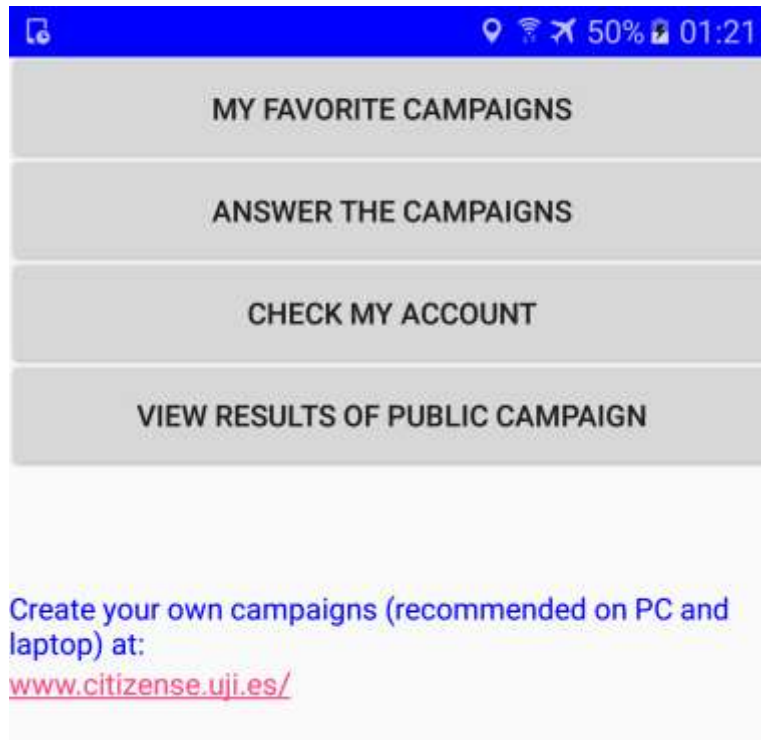


Figure 9: The main screen of the Cltizen app

To execute a sensing campaign, click on the button “Answer the campaigns” (Figure 9), a list of campaigns will be shown. You are free to select the campaign you want. After that, the app displays the general details of the campaign (Figure 10).

After this step, users can start executing the campaigns by completing each task as shown on the screen. Users can go back and forth in the list of campaigns.

2.3. View your own account

The app allows users to view their own account in real-time, to know their latest level of points and rewards. To do so, click on the “Check my account” button.

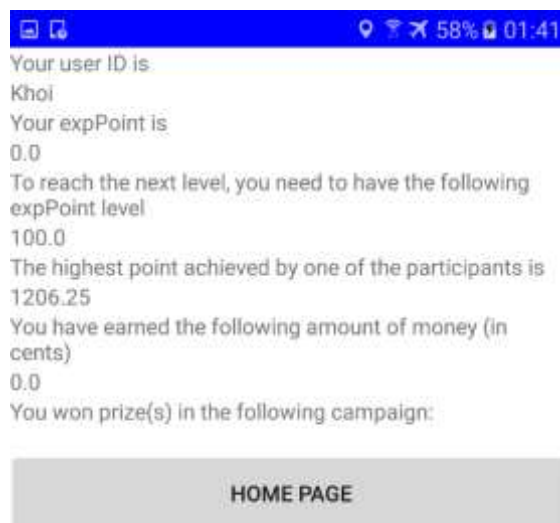


Figure 11: The details of a user's account
